As we approach our AGM, we are inviting members to step forward for two open Director positions on the LPRA Board. The Board consists of 11 directors serving two-year terms. For this year, six directors remain in term until 2026, and three are standing for re-election. We are particularly seeking members interested to serve as Treasurer (to transition into the role by December 2026) and a Communications Lead to oversee social media, member updates, and promotion of community events.

Directors are expected to attend monthly meetings, actively contribute to discussions, support or lead committees, and take accountability for key initiatives. Eligible candidates must be members in good standing for at least 12 months immediately prior to the election. If you are interested, please send a brief bio to info@longpointra.ca. As per our by-laws, any member may nominate a member for election to the board.

Regarding the proposed LPRA spending initiatives, thank you to those members who have proactively provided feedback via email. To ensure we gather broader feedback and help inform the discussion at the AGM, we have developed a short (approximately 2-minute) survey covering the three proposed initiatives. While more detailed information will be shared at the AGM, we are collecting feedback on these projects in advance to inform the discussion. Formal approval will take place in person at the AGM. The Board continues to assess the feasibility and implementation approach for each initiative, recognizing that delivery may occur on a phased basis.
